Tips

1. Write in such a way that others can relate to you in your past and present experiences. In other words, make it real, not overly churchy.
2. Give enough details to arouse interest. Be personal.
3. Edit carefully and rewrite as necessary before your final draft.
4. Emphasize the fact that the thing that made the difference in your life was accepting Christ as Savior and making Him Lord of your life.
5. Be real. Don't make it sound like your life is perfect and problem free since becoming a Christian.
6. Be positive from start to finish.
7. Make sure your testimony doesn't get bogged down with extraneous or nonessential information.
8. Remember to keep it to approximately three minutes.
